	Details: • Eastern Marin County and isolated areas in Sonoma and Napa counties could see Moderate HeatRisk (Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.) • High temperatures in the upper 80s to middle 90s expected in the interior valleys • Some uncertainty in the upper level pattern could result in lower or higher temperatures

	Details: • Southeastern San Mateo County (along Highway 101) could see Moderate HeatRisk (Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.) • High temperatures in the lower to middle 80s expected in southeastern San Mateo County • Some uncertainty in the upper level pattern could result in lower or higher temperatures
East Bay	
 Heat	Impacts: Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration. Timing: Wednesday and Thursday Confidence: Moderate

Santa Cruz County

Timing:

Wednesday and Thursday

Confidence:

Moderate

Details:

- Isolated locations near the cities of Santa Cruz, Watsonville, and Boulder Creek could see Moderate HeatRisk (Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.)
- High temperatures in the middle 80s to middle 90s expected away from the immediate coast
- Some uncertainty in the upper level pattern could result in lower or higher temperatures

Monterey & San Benito County

Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Wednesday and Thursday

Confidence:

Moderate

Details:

- Moderate HeatRisk forecast for the Santa Lucia range, the northern Salinas Valley, Pinnacles NP, and the Hollister area
- Other areas within Monterey and San Benito counties see Minor HeatRisk (Low Risk for heat-related illnesses for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.)
- High temperatures in the upper 80s to upper 90s expected in the interior valleys
- Some uncertainty in the upper level pattern could result in lower or higher temperatures

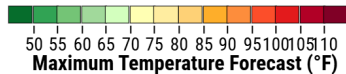

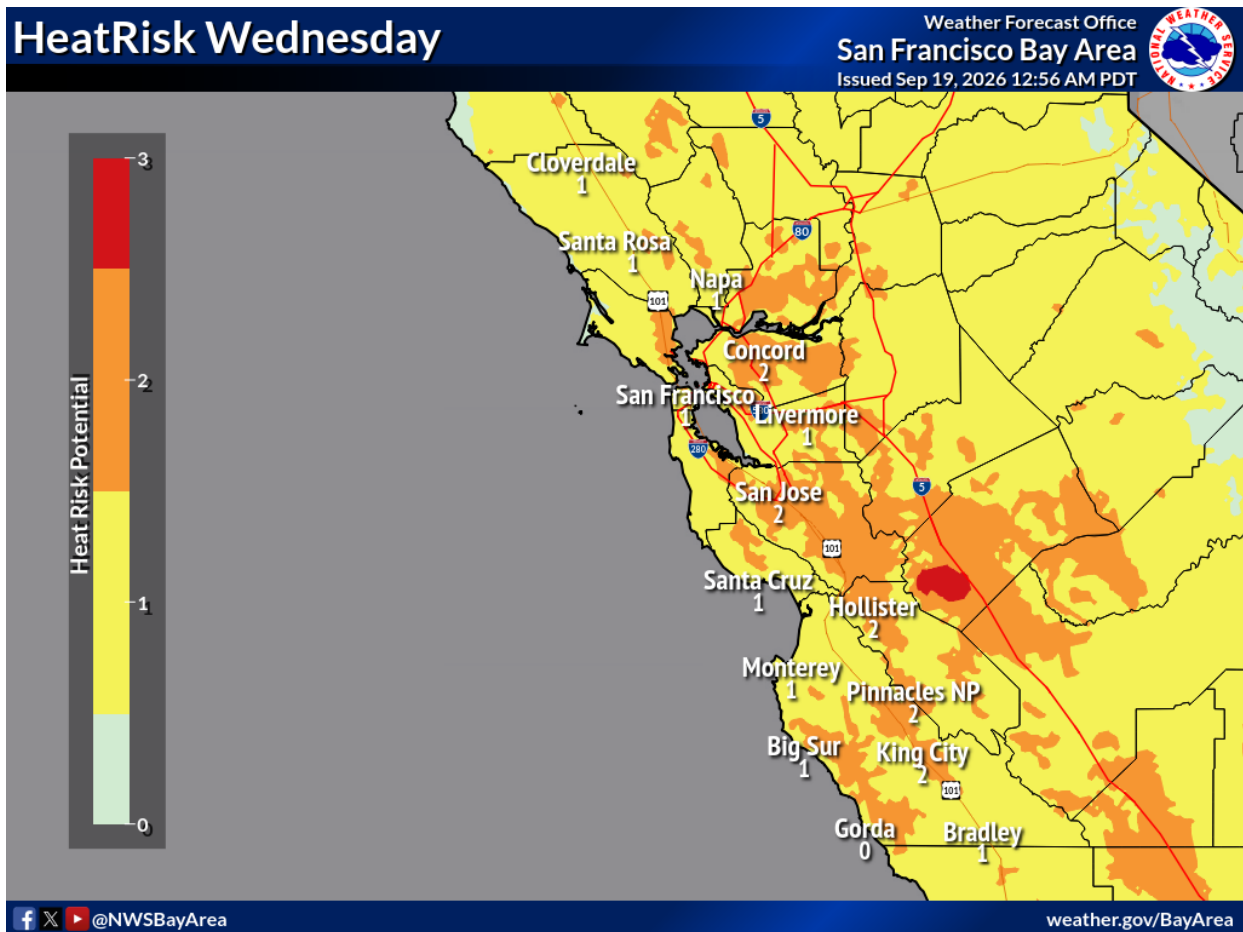
